A Bylaw to establish a Reserve Fund for Alternative Transportation Infrastructu	re

WHEREAS Section 525 of the *Local Government Act* authorizes the local government to establish by bylaw, a Reserve Fund for the purpose of providing transportation infrastructure that supports walking, bicycling, public transit, or other alternative forms of transportation, with money from other provisions in the Act,

AND WHEREAS the City of Surrey, pursuant to Part 5 Section B.1. of the Zoning By-law, may reduce the number of required parking spaces where the owner makes a cash contribution to the City of Surrey,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

ı. Title:

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes, as "Alternative Transportation Infrastructure Reserve Fund Bylaw, 2019, No. 19769".

2. Deposit of money into the Alternative Transportation Infrastructure Reserve Fund (the "Fund"):

All money paid to the City of Surrey by owners in lieu of providing off-street parking spaces within the proposed development site for the purposes of providing transportation infrastructure that supports walking, bicycling, public transit or other alternative forms of transportation, shall be deposited into the Fund.

3. Investment of Money in the Fund:

Money paid into the Fund may, until required to be used, be invested in the manner provided in the *Community Charter* for the investment of municipal funds, and interest earned from the money deposited in the Fund shall be deposited into the Fund.

4. Expenditure of Money in the Fund:

Money deposited in the Fund, together with the interest on it, must only be used for providing transportation infrastructure that supports walking, bicycling, public transit or other alternative forms of transportation.
