SUBJECT: Award of Contract No. 1720-012-21 Intersection Improvements Package #1

RECOMMENDATION

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract No. 1720-012-21 to 1336238 BC Ltd. dba Cancon Construction Ltd. in the amount of \$1,308,948.90 (including GST), for intersection improvements at various locations;
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract No. 1720-012-21 at \$1,440,000.00 (including GST and contingency); and
- 3. Authorize the General Manager, Engineering to execute Contract No. 1720-012-21.

SCOPE OF WORK

The construction package related to this contract consists of the installation of three traffic circles and an intersection upgrade at the locations listed in the following table, which are also illustrated on the map attached to this report as Appendix "I":

The contract permits construction from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, which is in compliance with the City's *Noise Control Bylaw*, 1982, *No.* 7044. The contract does not include an option for contractors to work 24-hours a day, 7-days a week, as the work is located within residential areas.

The contract work is expected to start in April 2022 and be completed by July 2022.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on March 18, 2022, with the following results:

The Engineer's (Aplin & Martin Consultant Ltd) pre-tender estimate was \$1.42 million, including GST.

EVALUATION

The submissions were reviewed for accuracy and completeness. There was one minor arithmetic error found which had no bearing on the outcome of the tender process. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond and were signed on the Tender Form.

The low bidder, 1336238 BC Ltd. dba Cancon Construction Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 80 working days, as stipulated in the contract. 1336238 BC Ltd. dba Cancon Construction Ltd. is a recently incorporated company and therefore have limited experience undertaking intersection improvements. However, based on reference checks, the contractors' personnel on the project are experienced and have undertaken similar work with satisfactory performance. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that 1336238 BC Ltd. dba Cancon Construction Ltd. be awarded Contract No. 1720-012-21.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The work of this Contract supports the objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter 2.0. In particular, the project supports the Sustainability Charter 2.0 theme of Infrastructure. Specifically, this project supports the following Desired Outcomes ("DOs"):


- All Infrastructure DO1: City facilities and infrastructure systems are well managed, adaptable and long lasting, and are effectively integrated into regional systems; and
