RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract No. 1718-046-11 4719-058-11 to Complete Utility Contractors Ltd. in the amount of \$3,065,166.30, (including GST), for the 132 Street sanitary trunk sewer improvements;
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract No. 4719-058-11 at \$3,370,000.00 (including GST and contingency); and
- 3. Authorize the General Manager, Engineering to execute Contract No. 4719-058-11.

SCOPE OF WORK

The construction package related to this contract consists of upgrades to the existing sanitary trunk sewer along 132 Street from King George Boulevard to 114 Avenue, along with the installation of a new sanitary pump station and forcemain. This work will support development in the northern portion of City Centre by providing additional sewer capacity. The local pump station will provide improved service to approximately 25 homes within the area that are located in close proximity to Metro Vancouver's North Surrey Interceptor. The project locations are listed in the following table, which are also illustrated on the map attached to this report as Appendix "I":

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The Contract permits construction from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, in compliance with the *Surrey Noise Control Bylaw*, 1982, No. 7044. The Contract does not include an option for contractors to work 24-hours a day, seven days a week as the work is located within a residential area.

Construction of the contract work is expected to start in May 2022 and be completed by October 2022.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on April 1, 2022 with the following results:

The Engineer's (ISL Engineering) pre-tender estimate was \$2.9 million, including GST.

EVALUATION

The submissions were reviewed for accuracy and completeness. There were no errors. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed on the Tender Form.

The low bidder, Complete Utility Contractors Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 125 working days, as stipulated in the contract. Complete Utility Contractors Ltd. past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Complete Utility Contractors Ltd. be awarded Contract No. 4719-058-11.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The work of this Contract supports the objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter 2.0. In particular, the project supports the Sustainability Charter 2.0 theme Infrastructure. Specifically, this project supports the following Desired Outcomes ("DOs") and Strategic Direction ("SD"):


Funding for this contract is available in the approved 2022 Utilities Budget.
