


'EVERYDAY LIFE IN **SURREY**

TIMELINE*

April 22, 2024: Call open

May 19, 2024: Submission deadline

Saturday, June 22, 2024, 10am-2pm or Wednesday June 19, 2024, 4-6pm at Cloverdale Community Centre: Artwork delivery dates. Artworks will not be accepted outside of these times.

June 29-October 9, 2024: Exhibition dates

Saturday, October 12, 2024, 10am-2pm or Wednesday, October 16, 2024, 4-6pm at Cloverdale Community Centre: Artwork pickup dates. Artworks will not be available for pickup outside of these times.

- Are 2D and ready to hang. Unframed/unmounted artworks will not be accepted.
- Reflect the theme "Everyday Life in Surrey."
- Appropriate for all audiences.

APPLICATION CONTENTS


Please include:

- O Name

- O Brief statement about your artwork (no more than 30 words), including themes, inspirations, or concepts you want the viewer to know about.
- O Photos of each artwork in a high resolution.
- O Details for each artwork: name, dimensions, medium (what kind of material did you use?)
- O Please prioritize your submitted artworks in order of preference for display. Note that we cannot guarantee that all pieces will be displayed.
- O Permission to use submitted photos in promotional materials.
