## TITLE: SURREY GOOD CITIZEN OF THE YEAR

- 1. This Policy shall be reviewed on a yearly basis prior to soliciting for nominations.
- 2. Nominations will be solicited through social media, the City's website, and word of mouth, for a period not less than 6 weeks.
- 3. Nominations should be submitted to the Legislative Services Department and will be accepted from individuals and organizations.
- 4. Selection criteria includes that:
  - The individual is a current resident or business owner during the years of service under consideration;
  - The honour be awarded to an individual who has given outstanding service for at least 15 years;
  - Volunteer contributions have had a positive influence in the City of Surrey and to its residents;
  - That elected officials currently holding office, not be considered for this award;
  - That any person that is not politically active including former elected officials may be considered for this award.
- 5. When selecting a recipient of the award Council will also consider the diversity and demographics in the City and look to ensure that the award recipients reflective of this over time.
- 6. The nominations of each candidate shall be reviewed by Council and a simple majority vote is required to select a recipient of the Surrey Good Citizen of the Year Award.
