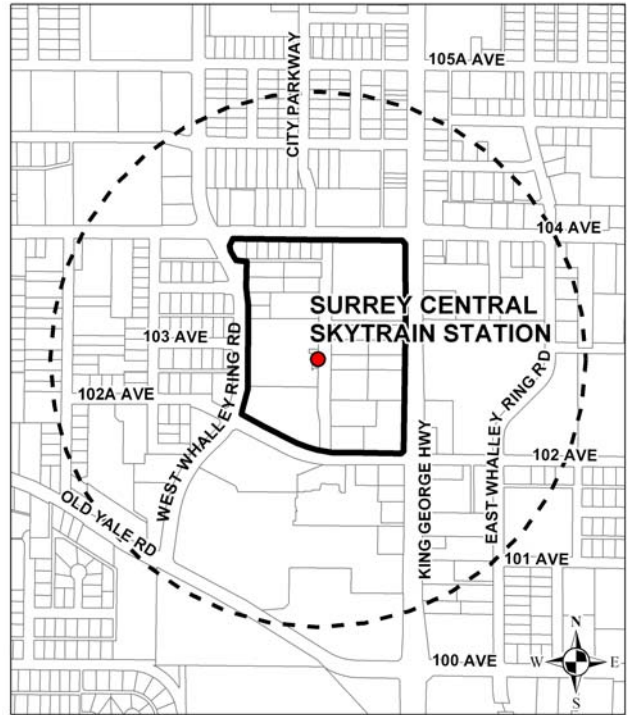
Surrey Central Transit Village Project

A Public Open House will be held on Wednesday, October 26, 2005 to present preliminary Options for the Surrey Central Transit Village Plan. The Open House will provide information on the study now underway, share information on the preliminary design concepts, and hear ideas from the public on the future of this area.

The Surrey Central Transit Village is one of the six components of the Urban Transportation Showcase Program, funded through a partnership with Transport Canada, the City of Surrey, the GVRD and TransLink, to encourage Canadian municipalities to adopt transportation and land use patterns and practices that promote sustainable forms of transportation such as transit, walking, and cycling.

The Plan is exploring options for a finer street grid to create streets that are safe and attractive for pedestrians, cyclists, vehicles and transit. As well, transit operations in the area are being reviewed. The goal is to create an attractive, safe, compact, high-density, mixed-use community, centred on the SkyTrain station that encourages investment in the area, and is inviting to residents, workers, shoppers, students and visitors in the area.

The study area is within 500 metres of the Surrey Central SkyTrain Station, with specific focus on the area bounded by 102 and 104 Avenue, and West Whalley Ring Road and King George Highway.
