

**A. MOTION TO HOLD A MEETING IN A CLOSED SESSION**

It is in order for Council to pass a resolution to close the meeting to the public pursuant to Section 90 (1)(e) and (i) of the *Community Charter*, which states:

"A part of a council meeting may be closed to the public if the subject matter being considered relates to or is one or more of the following:

- (e) the acquisition, disposition or expropriation of land or improvements, if the council considers that disclosure could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality."
- (i) The receipt of advice that is subject to solicitor-client privilege, including communications for that purpose."
