 into the matter in dispute between C<sup>o</sup> Figg  
 and the complainants and report,

 that the matter of statute labor be left  
 exclusively with the pathmaster as  
 provided by By-Law the council declin-  
 ing to interfere,  
 carried.

Moved by C<sup>o</sup> Johnson see by C<sup>o</sup> Cameron that  
 Mr Stevenson be allowed to do his <sup>last year</sup> statute  
 labor as pathmaster reports that he was prevented  
 solely by the fact that the Elgin bridge was  
 impassible  
 carried

The clerk was instructed to write the Solicitor re the permissibility of building part of the survey Lyke for a road, <sup>as soon as it had been</sup> ~~as it is now~~ replaced by a new and is not needed for dyking purposes, provided that all parties concerned give their consent in writing.
