

WHY BUY FROM LOCAL FARMERS?

Agriculture plays an important part in Surrey's economy. Approximately one third of Surrey's total land base is zoned agricultural and is home to over 475 farms. Surrey is a significant producer of the province's vegetables. Over 50 percent of BC's lettuce, radishes, carrots and spinach come from Surrey farms.

We encourage you to support local farms and to experience agriculture in the City. In an ongoing effort to promote agricultural growth in our community, the City has published the 2010 Farm Fresh Guide to help you get to know the source of your food by visiting farms, markets and u-pick locations.

Buying local products is also a healthy choice for you and the environment. By eating products that are in season and available from local farms your foods will be ripe and fresh, and you will reduce the shipping distances your food makes. There will be less fuel consumed and less vehicle emissions from the shorter shipping distances. It will also be less likely that your foods will be involved in preservation or ripening processes used during international shipping.
