

'Try It' 55+ Sports and Games Passport Contest

Official Rules & Regulations

1) ENTRY PERIOD:

The Main Contest begins at 9:00 a.m. on June 3 2024 and ends at 11:59 p.m. on June 8, 2024.

2) ELIGIBILITY: You must be fifty-five (55+) years or older and a legal resident of Surrey. If you are under fifty-five years of age you are not eligible to participate in the contest. City of Surrey employees and immediate family members of City of Surrey employees are not eligible to enter. The prize winner will be required to show government issued ID

Main Contest:

Between June 3, 2024 and June 8, 2024, to participate, register for one or more of the 'Try It' activities. You will receive a passport at the location of your first attended activity. Remember to bring your passport to the activities you've registered for.

- At the end of the activity, the activity leader will stamp your passport.
- Each stamp on the passport earns you an entry into the draw.
- The more stamps you collect, the better your chance of winning the prize.
