

BLOOM & FRUITS

Delicate pendant flowers, with outer red and inner yellow petals, blooming from May to June.

FEATURES

Delicate airy foliage in spring to early summer dies back and goes dormant in late summer heat.

USE BY PEOPLE & CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE The Haida believe that 'red rain-flowers' should not be picked or it would rain. Different indigenous groups had various medicinal uses for the roots and leaves.

WILDLIFE VALUE

Flowers are favoured by butterflies and hummingbirds.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Hybridizes readily with cultivated varieties so keep well separate if you want to propagate from seed.
