BY-LAW NO. 12935

A by-law to stop up and close a portion of  
Portion of 161 Street.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey, pursuant to Section 578 of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 290, R.S.B.C., may by by-law, stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portion of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. 161 Street, at a line commencing at a point on the Easterly boundary of Lot Ninety-Five (95), Section Twelve (12), Township One (1), New Westminster District, Plan Fifty-Two Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Four (52234), said point being 6.120 metres Northwesterly from the most Easterly corner of the said Lot 95; and

Thence Southeasterly on a circular curve to the right having a radius of 13.120 metres more or less to the most Northerly corner of Strata Plan NW Two Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Six (2226), Section Twelve (12), Township (1), New Westminster District,

Said line shown heavy dashed on sketch attached hereto to this by-law,

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of 161 Street Road Closing By-law, 1996, No. 12935."

PASSED THREE READINGS on the 30th day of September, 1996.
