BY-LAW NO. 13575

A by-law to amend the provisions of "Smoke Alarm By-law, 1993, No. [12136](#)".

The Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Smoke Alarm By-law, 1993, No. [12136](#)" is hereby amended as follows:

(a) The definition of "Smoke Alarm" in Section 2 is amended by deleting clause (b) and inserting new clause (b) in its place as follows:

"(b) conforms to the CAN/ULC-S531-M87 standard for smoke alarms."

(b) The definition of "Smoke Alarm" in Section 2 is amended by deleting clause (c) in its entirety.

(c) Section 6 is deleted and new Section 6 is inserted in its place as follows:

"6. A Smoke Alarm which is installed in a Suite or Dwelling Unit which is owner-occupied may be hard-wired or individually battery powered, except that where the owner-occupied Suite or Dwelling Unit is located in a Building in which one or more additional Suite(s) or Dwelling Units(s) are rented the Smoke Alarm must be hard-wired."

2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Smoke Alarm By-law, 1993, No. [12136](#), Amendment By-law, 1998, No. 13575."

PASSED THREE READINGS on the 2nd day of November, 1998.
