BY-LAW NO. 16061

A by-law to establish a Delegation of Council Authority pursuant to Section 154 of the "Community Charter".

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 154 of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c.26, the City Council may delegate its powers, duties and functions, including those specifically established by an enactment, to an officer or employee of the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Council does hereby delegate to the Acting City Manager the authority to award contracts from July 29 to September 10, 2006

provided that:

- tenders are received in an open public tender;
  - the award is to the lowest tender;
  - the construction tender is no more than 10% over the Engineer's pre-tender estimate.
2. This By-law shall be cited as "Surrey Delegation of Council Authority By-law, 2006, No. 16061".

PASSED FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD READING on the 10th day of July, 2006.
