BY-LAW NO. 16278

A by-law to authorize the expenditure of monies  
in the “Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within  
Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas.”

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 188(1) of the “Community Charter”, being Chapter 26, of the Statutes of B.C., 2003, as amended, Council has established a Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 189(1) of the said “Community Charter”, it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside in the Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of Two Million Two Hundred Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$2,235,000) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas, specifically for:
  - a) North Cloverdale West, Library Services, in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000);
  - b) North Cloverdale West, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000);
  - c) North Cloverdale West, Police Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
  - d) East Newton North, Park Development, in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000);
  - e) East Newton South, Library Services, in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000);
  - f) East Newton South, Parks Development, in the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000);

- g) East Newton South, Police Services, in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000);
- h) East Clayton, Fire Services, in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000);
- i) East Clayton, Library Services, in the sum of One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$130,000);
- j) East Clayton, Park Development, in the sum of Eight Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$830,000);
- k) East Clayton North Extension, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- l) East Clayton North Extension, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000);
- m) West Cloverdale North, Library Services, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- n) West Cloverdale North, Park Development, in the sum of Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000);
- o) West Cloverdale North, Police Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- p) West Cloverdale South, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- q) West Cloverdale South, Park Development, in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000);
- r) West Newton Highway 10, Park Development, in the sum of Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000);
- s) West Newton South, Park Development, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- t) Rosemary Heights Central, Fire Services, in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000);
- u) Rosemary Heights Central, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- v) Rosemary Heights Central, Park Development, in the sum of Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000);

- w) Rosemary Heights Central, Police Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- x) South Newton, Library Services, in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000);
- y) South Newton, Park Development, in the sum of Two Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$215,000);
- z) South Newton, Police Services, in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000);
- aa) Fleetwood Town Centre, Library Services, in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000);
- bb) Fleetwood Town Centre, Park Development, in the sum of Two Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000), and
- cc) North Grandview Heights Amendment Area, Parks Development, in the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000).

To be expended for the following purpose for the Year 2007:

NCP Specified Park Development	\$ 1,855,000
Library Materials	280,000
Fire Services	50,000
Police Services	<u>50,000</u>
	<u>\$ 2,235,000</u>

2. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditure hereby authorized has been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
3. This by-law shall be cited for all purposes as “Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas Reserve Fund Expenditure Authorization By-law, 2007 No. 16278”.
