

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 16519

A by-law to amend the provisions of “Surrey Board of Variance By-law, 2004, No. 15317” as amended.

The Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. “Surrey Board of Variance By-law, 2004, No. 15317” as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
 1. Section 10 is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and replacing it with the following: “Every person submitting a notice of application to the Board shall pay to the City at the time of application, the application fee as defined in Schedule E of “Surrey Fee Setting By-law, 2001, No. 14577, as amended and no application shall be received by the person duly authorized until payment of such fee is made”.
 2. Section 11 is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and replacing it with the following: “Upon a decision being made by the Board, the applicant may, within sixty (60) days of the decision, make a further application to the Board if the application relates to the same matter as the original appeal but varies the relaxation requested. This second application shall be accompanied by a fee as defined in Schedule E of “Surrey Fee Setting By-law, 2001, No. 14577, as amended”.
2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as “Surrey Board of Variance By-law, 2004, No. 15317, Amendment By-law, 2007, No. 16519”.
