

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 16750

A by-law to establish a Delegation of Council Authority
pursuant to Section 154 of the "Community Charter".
.....

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 154 of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c.26, the City Council may delegate its powers, duties and functions, including those specifically established by an enactment, to an officer or employee of the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Council does hereby delegate to the City Manager the authority to award the following contract on the basis of best value to the City:

(a) RFP #1220-30-19-08 Fraser Heights Tennis Facility

2. That Council does hereby delegate to the City Manager the authority to award the following contracts:

(a) Contract M.S. 1706-013-11 Arterial Widening: 132 Street: from 62B Avenue to 64 Avenue

(b) Contract M.S. 1705-001-41 Bridge: Fraser Highway/Serpentine River

(c) Contract M.S. 1708-011-11 Various Locations: Pathways/Sidewalk

(d) Contract M.S. 4707-002-11 Various Locations: Sewer System Improvements

provided that:

- tenders are received in an open public tender;
- the award is to the lowest tender;
- the construction tender is no more than 10% over the Engineer's pre-tender estimate.

3. This By-law shall be cited as "Surrey Delegation of Council Authority By-law, 2008, No. 16750".

PASSED FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD READING on the 28th day of July, 2008.
