BY-LAW NO. 16836

A by-law to authorize the expenditure of monies  
in the “Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within  
Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas.”

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 188(1) of the “Community Charter”, being Chapter 26, of the Statutes of B.C., 2003, as amended, Council has established a Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 189(1) of the said “Community Charter”, it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside in the Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of Four Million Four Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$4,415,000) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas, specifically for:
  - a) North Cloverdale West, Library Services, in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000);
  - b) North Cloverdale West, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000);
  - c) North Cloverdale West, Police Services, in the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000);
  - d) East Newton North, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
  - e) East Newton North, Park Development, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);

- f) East Newton South, Fire Services, in the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000);
- g) East Newton South, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- h) East Newton South, Park Development, in the sum of Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000);
- i) East Newton South, Police Services, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- j) Clayton, Park Development, in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000);
- k) Clayton, Police Services, in the sum of Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000);
- l) East Clayton, Library Services, in the sum of One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000);

- o) East Clayton North Extension, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- p) East Clayton North Extension, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000);
- q) East Clayton North Extension, Police Services, in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000);
- r) West Cloverdale North, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- s) West Cloverdale North, Park Development, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- t) West Cloverdale North, Police Services, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- u) West Cloverdale South, Park Development, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);

- v) West Newton Highway 10, Park Development, in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000);
- w) West Newton North, Park Development, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- x) West Newton South, Park Development, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- y) Rosemary Heights West, Park Development, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- z) Rosemary Heights West, Police Services, in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000);
- aa) Rosemary Heights Central, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- bb) Rosemary Heights Central, Park Development, in the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000);
- cc) Rosemary Heights Central, Police Services, in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000);
- dd) Rosemary Heights Business & Industrial, Park Development, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- ee) Douglas, Park Development, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- ff) Douglas, Police Services, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- gg) South Newton, Library Services, in the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000);
- hh) South Newton, Park Development, in the sum of Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$220,000);
- ii) South Newton, Police Services, in the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000);
- jj) Fleetwood Town Centre, Library Services, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- kk) Fleetwood Town Centre, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000);

- ll) Fleetwood Town Centre, Police Services, in the sum of Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000);
- mm) Campbell Heights, Fire Services, in the sum of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$280,000);
- nn) Campbell Heights, Park Development, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- oo) Campbell Heights, Police Services, in the sum of Six Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$680,000);
- pp) North Grandview Heights Amendment, Fire Services, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- qq) North Grandview Heights Amendment, Library Services, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000);
- rr) North Grandview Heights Amendment, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000);
- ss) North Grandview Heights Amendment, Police Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- tt) North Grandview Heights, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000);
- uu) North Grandview Heights, Park Development, in the sum of Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000);
- vv) Morgan Heights, Fire Services, in the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000);
- ww) Morgan Heights, Library Services, in the sum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000);
- xx) Morgan Heights, Park Development, in the sum of Five Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$530,000);
- yy) Morgan Heights, Police Services, in the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000);
- zz) Highway 99 Corridor, Fire Services, in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000), and

aaa) Highway 99 Corridor, Police Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000).

To be expended for the following purpose for the Year 2009:

NCP Specified Park Development	\$ 2,260,000
Library Materials	400,000
Fire Services	525,000
Police Services	<u>1,230,000</u>
	<u>\$ 4,415,000</u>

2. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditure hereby authorized has been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
3. This by-law shall be cited for all purposes as “Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas Reserve Fund Expenditure Authorization By-law, 2008, No. 16836”.
