BY-LAW NO. 16894

A by-law to amend the provisions of "Surrey Tree Protection Bylaw, 2006, No. 16100 " as amended.

The Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Surrey Tree Protection Bylaw, 2006, No. 16100" as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
  - a) Part 8 is amended by deleting Section 46 (d) in its entirety and replacing it with the new Section 46 (d) as follows:
    - (d) The total amount of security deposited under Section 46 may not exceed ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$100,000.00) DOLLARS or, in the case of a single family subdivision, TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000.00) DOLLARS per lot created by the subdivision, whichever amount is lower, for each tree cutting permit or for each subdivision application, development permit, development variance permit, building permit or demolition permit, to be held by the City for a period of two (2) years after final building approval to ensure that the trees are properly protected and maintained in accordance with this Bylaw and the tree cutting permit.
2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Tree Protection Bylaw, 2006, No. 16100, Amendment By-law, 2009, No. 16894."
