The Honourable Rita Johnston, Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Honourable Bill Reid, Minister of Tourism, Recreation and Culture and Joan Smallwood, MLA, were present to address Council.

Rita Johnston firstly made reference to the Premier's Conference that was held last week. Mrs. Johnston thanked Mayor Ross for his participation in this meeting which was a valuable exercise for all participants.

Mr. Reid then emphasized the cooperation that had been established between Surrey's MLAs and Council over the past number of years.

Joan Smallwood pointed out that she was looking forward to a long and fruitful relationship with Surrey Council.

Alderman Higginbotham then made reference to the new census figure for Surrey and noted the problems that Surrey now faced in keeping up with the demands of our new citizens.

Mr. Reid made reference to the expansion of the ALRT to Surrey, the provision of the Alex Fraser Bridge and the need for infra-structure improvements.

Mrs. Johnston noted the approval of funding for the permanent campus for Kwantlen College, the financial assistance for the Newton Leisure Centre, as well as the Provincial revenue sharing grants.

Alderman Watkins briefly noted that each of the Surrey MLA's represented approximately 60,000 constituents and suggested that there should be a fair redistribution. Alderman Watkins also indicated that the Province currently does not have a proper long-range plan for education.

Mrs. Johnston indicated that the Royal Commission on education would deal with such a plan and suggested that Alderman Watkins make a presentation to the Commission.

Alderman Schrenk made reference to the overcrowding at Surrey Memorial Hospital, commented on the need for a pedestrian crossing on Scott Road at approximately 70 Avenue and requested information on tourism from Expo.

Mrs. Johnston indicated that she had met with representatives from the Sikh Temple earlier in the day and she was following up the provision of a pedestrian signal on Scott Road with the Ministry of Highways. Mrs. Johnston also indicated that she was continually working on the hospital and it was most difficult to continually satisfy the new demands.

Mr. Reid briefly pointed out that the tourist statistics on post Expo tourism were very positive. Mr. Reid pointed out that the new visits in November were up by 22% and December and January were proving to be record months as well. Mr. Reid also commented on the provision of a second sheet of ice in South Surrey and indicated that funding up to \$400,000 would be available through his Ministry.


