The Municipal Council met at 10.00 o'clock a.m. in Special Session called by notice given in pursuance of the provisions of Section 34 of the "Municipal Act" for the purpose of considering and dealing with an Agreement between the Attorney General of the Province and The Corporation for the policing of the District of Surrey by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Force and also to consider recommendations of the Board of Police Commissioners in respect of the disposition to be made of members of the Municipal Police Force. All of the members were present with the exception of Councillor Johnston.

The Clerk supplied each of the members with a copy of the draft of Agreement submitted by the Hon. the Attorney General, covering the policing of the Municipality by the R.C.M.P.

The draft Agreement was then read and considered in detail.

Moved by Councillor Stewart  
Seconded by Councillor Atchison

That the draft of Agreement between the Province and the District of Surrey for the policing of the Municipality of Surrey by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police be approved in toto and that the Reeve and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute said Agreement on behalf of The Corporation of the District of Surrey.

Carried.

The recommendation of the Board of Police Commissioners regarding placement of the members of the police force, not absorbed into the R.C.M.P. Force was considered to some length.

Seconded by Councillor Miller

That the recommendations of the Board of Police Commissioners regarding employment of members of the Municipal Police Force be accepted and efforts made to provide employment for those members of the Force who wish to continue in municipal service.

Carried.

The question of arranging for collection of dog taxes was considered.

Seconded by Councillor Miller

That Constable Douglas be retained on the municipal staff as Collector of Dog Taxes and that he be paid 20% of the taxes collected by him for his services plus an allowance of \$75.00 per month for use of his car on municipal business.

Carried.

Moved by Councillor Atchison  
Seconded by Councillor McPherson  
That a position of Assistant to the License Inspector

be created and applications be invited to fill the position from the members of the Municipal Police Force.

Carried.

Moved by Councillor McPherson  
Seconded by Councillor Miller  
That the meeting do now adjourn.
