present - Rev. W. W. Doyall in the chair. Communications were
read from J. M. B. Smith, Auditor of B. C., enclosing cheque
for \$36.75 and voucher for the \$100⁰⁰ appropriated to the Muni-
cipality, from W. S. Gore regarding gazetting highways, from
H. J. Thrift - about Halls Prairie Road, from Thomas Pickard
asking for \$80⁰⁰ on his contract - and from Wm. Shannon
asking the appointment of committee to inspect his job.
The tenders for the Government work on the Clover Valley road
were opened and J. W. Pickard's tender being the lowest, which was
193 rods for \$300⁰⁰, Councillor Shannon moved sic. by Councillor Stewart
that - the lowest tender be accepted, carried.
Moved by Councillor Morton sic. by Councillor Johnston that -

the clerk be instructed to apply for ^{\$}300⁰⁰ of Govt-~~money~~^{carried} appropriation for trunk roads for expenditure in this municipality
Moved by com Stewart - sec. by com Shannon that
the clerk be instructed to advertise the intention of the Council
to apply to the Chief Commissioner of Lands & Works
to have the following roads gazetted 33 and 66 feet wide respect-
ively: viz; the $\frac{1}{2}$ section line south of the Township line between
Townships 1 and 2 beginning at the intersection of the Simiashung
road and said $\frac{1}{2}$ section line thence running west to the west-
line of section 33 Township 1 a distance of ^{about} one mile and 4 chains
and the section line between sections 30 & 31 and 29 & 32
Township 7 running east - from the Coast Meridian road
to the Halls Prairie Road. Carried.

time for receiving tenders for the Steam Ferry Slip
be extended to next meeting of Council. carried

Moved by com Morton sec by com Brown that ^{\$}100⁰⁰
be expended in repairing Carr's road. carried

Moved by com Shannon sec. by com Johnston and
Resolved that the Council, not having funds, would
respectfully recommend the expenditure by the Government
of ^{\$}500⁰⁰ in repairing the north end of the Johnston road
Township II. The work being necessary owing to the large

number of settlers in this township who have no other outlet - except this road, which is at present simply impassible. Carried.

Moved by com. Shannon sic by com Brown that - Mr Thomas Pickard be allowed \$80⁰⁰ on his job on the Clover Valley road and that the clerk be instructed to collect the ~~money~~ ^{money} from the subscriptions to the same. Carried

Moved by com Stewart - sic by com Brown that - the clerk be instructed to notify Mr John Stevenson to put a bridge across his ditch on the Hookway Road. Carried

Moved by com Brown sic by com Stewart - that the council do now adjourn to meet again on the 13th day of September at 1 o'clock P.M. Carried.
