The Board of Police Commissioners  
met at 6.30 pm.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

The Reeve reported a recommendation of the Municipal Council that the allowance being made to Constable Mortimer over and above the compensation paid by the Workmen's Compensation Board should now be discontinued.

The matter was laid over for a fully attended meeting of the Board.

Resolved that the salaries of the staff be increased as from the 1<sup>st</sup> proximo to the following amounts, namely: -

Constable J. L. Craig - to \$120.00 per month

Constable J. J. Matheson to \$130.00 per month

Chief E. J. Jaler - to \$175.00 per month

Constable W. J. Moffat - to \$160.00 per month

Secretary J. G. Farmer - to \$15.00 per month

The Reeve, Commissioner Mr. Beth and the Chief of Police, were given power to act in the matter of adjusting Constable Moffat's car allowance.

The Chief of Police suggested that in view of the present troublous times it might be useful to have a sub-machine gun of the pattern issued to the army, one of which he thought he could obtain on loan from Capt. Suddall.

No objection was offered.

The meeting then adjourned.
