Halls Prairie Road Andrew A Hart for \$345<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub>. Simiahnow Road the tender being too high Com Morton moved me by Com Brown that the clerk be instructed to write Mr H. H. Mackenzie and see what he means by his lowest tender on above roads. Carried

Changes proposed in the specifications of the work on serpentine flats, from clerk of New Westminster City Council enclosing letter of Capt Grant asking alterations in the Survey Steam Ferry Bylaw, from Auditor of B.C., enclosing voucher for \$36.75-<sup>00</sup> due the Municipality from the last year's Govt-  
appropriation and also regarding the present year's appropriation of \$1000<sup>00</sup> from A.A. Hart applying for 30% of this contract on Browns road to the Municipality, and from B.B. Smith resigning the position of Immigration agent for Survey.

Moved by Com Brown sec by Com Stewart - that the clerk be instructed to write the City Council that this Council will change the schedule to the Steam Ferry Bylaw to 75-cents per ton for general freight - and that is the only change they will make.

Moved by Com Stewart - sec, by Com Brown that the clerk be instructed to apply to the Hon. Chief Commissioner of Lands and Works to have the 1/2 section line south of the township line between Townships 1 and 2 beginning at the intersection of the Suniahmoo Road and said 1/2 section line thence running west to the west line of section 33 Township 1 a distance of about 1 mile and 4 chains, gazetted as a road 33 feet wide; also the section line between sections 30 and 31 and sections 29 and 32 Township 7 running east from the Coast-  
Meridian road to the Falls Prairie Road gazetted as a road 66 feet wide. carried.

The Recorder here stated that \$500<sup>00</sup> had been appropriated by the Government for the section line 1 mile east of Coast Meridian in Township 7 to be refunded through the Municipal Council, and by motion of councillor Brown sec by Stewart - Coun Morton and Shannon were appointed to examine the road and make out specifications for the same and the clerk was instructed to call for tenders, tenders to be in at the next meeting.

Moved by Coun Brown sec by Coun Shannon that the clerk be instructed to write in reply to the Auditor of B.C.'s letter of July 19 and apply for the appropriation of 1000<sup>00</sup> to this Municipality the amount to be placed in the Bank of B.C., Carried.

Moved by Coun Brown sec. by Coun. Shannon that Mr Hart be allowed an advance of \$30<sup>00</sup> on his contract on Browns Road, Carried.

Moved by Coun Stewart - sec by Coun Brown that the communication of Mr H. D. Chantrell respecting the obstruction on the Blackie Spit road be taken off file. Carried.

Moved by Coun Stewart - sec by Coun Brown that the clerk be instructed to write Mr John Stevenson to remove his fence and other obstructions which he has put in the Blackie Spit Road, Carried.

Moved by Coun Stewart - sec by Coun Brown that the previous motion in regard the tenders on the Sumichnow road be rescinded and that Mr Joseph Wise's tender be accepted provided that the Gov't will grant the additional amount required. Carried.
