

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 10628

A By-law to establish a reserve fund for
the depreciation and obsolescence of
Firefighting Equipment.

.....

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 378(1)(c) of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 290, RSBC 1979, the Council may, by by-law, establish a reserve fund for depreciation and obsolescence of any machinery and equipment;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable and expedient to provide for the depreciation and obsolescence of Firefighting Equipment which has been purchased in order that the costs of purchasing new equipment may be more equitably borne by the Municipal taxpayers;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, and in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Section 378(1)(c) of the "Municipal Act", ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. There is hereby set aside out of the general revenue funds of the Corporation, the sum of Six Hundred and Ninety-Three Thousand, Five Hundred and Ninety-Five Dollars and Thirty-Two Cents (\$693,595.32) as a reserve fund to be used solely for the purchase of Firefighting equipment for the use of The Corporation of the District of Surrey.
2. A further sum of money may be set aside annually out of the general revenue funds of the Corporation into this reserve to provide for depreciation and obsolescence of Firefighting equipment.
3. Until the said monies are required to be used for the purpose hereinbefore mentioned, the same may be invested in the manner provided in Section 364 and 365 of the "Municipal Act", being Chapter 290, RSBC 1979, for the investment of sinking funds.
4. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Firefighting Equipment Reserve By-law, 1990, No. 10628."

PASSED THREE READINGS by the Municipal Council on the 23rd day of July, 1990.
