

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 10829

A by-law to amend the provisions of
"Business License By-law, 1976, No.
4747", as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Business License By-law, 1976, No. 4747", as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

(a) Section 2, Interpretation, is hereby amended by inserting the definition for "Secondary Suite" after the definition for "Scrap Dealer" and before the definition for "Social Escort Service" as follows:

" 'Secondary Suite' means a second dwelling unit, not exceeding 75 square metres (800 square feet) in floor area, located within the structure of an owner-occupied single family house."

(b) SCHEDULE "A" OF BY-LAW NO. 7025 is hereby amended by inserting Section 76, Secondary Suite, after Section 75, Schools, Teaching, or Activity Instruction, and before Section 77, Shoe Repair Shops as follows:

"76. Secondary Suite

From every person carrying on the business of operating a secondary suite as defined under the Zoning By-law, the sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) for every twelve (12) months."

2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Business License By-law, 1976, No. 4747, Amendment By-law, 1991, No. 10829."

PASSED THREE READINGS by the Municipal Council on the 4th day of February, 1991.
