BY-LAW NO. 10899

A By-law to provide for a Five-Year  
Capital Budget for the Municipality of  
Surrey.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 266 of the "Municipal Act" being R.S.B.C. 1979 as amended, the Municipal Council is required to adopt by By-law a capital expenditure program for a period of not less than five years, showing estimates of the proposed source and application of funds for capital purposes for each year of the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Schedule "A" of this By-law No. [10899](#) is hereby adopted by the Municipal Council as the five-year capital expenditure for the years 1991 to 1995 inclusive and Schedule "A" is hereby attached to and made part of this By-law.
2. "Surrey Five-Year Capital Budget Adoption By-law, 1990, No. [10544](#)" is hereby repealed.
3. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Five-Year Capital Budget Adoption By-law, 1991, No. 10899."
