

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 10916

A by-law to amend the provisions of
"Surrey Zoning By-law, 1979, No. [5942](#),"
as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled,
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Surrey Zoning By-law, 1979, No. [5942](#)," as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

(a) PART I - DEFINITIONS is hereby amended as follows:

(i) The definition for "CONTAINER - HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE" is hereby inserted after the definition for "COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT" and before the definition for "CONTROL PLAN" as follows:

"CONTAINER - HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE'

means a container for the deposit of household waste material designed to facilitate transport to an off-site location for garbage disposal or periodic emptying into another container for such purpose."

(ii) The definition for "RECYCLABLE MATERIAL" is hereby inserted after the definition for "RECREATIONAL USES" and before the definition for "RECYCLING CONTAINER - PASSIVE" as follows:

"RECYCLABLE MATERIAL'

means paper, paper products, and containers made of glass, metal or plastic or such other material as may be collected under Municipal Contract."

(b) PART IV - GENERAL PROVISIONS is hereby amended in Section B, USES PERMITTED IN SPECIFIC ZONES, by inserting Sub-Section 8 after Sub-Section 7 as follows:

"8. Containers for Garbage and Recyclable Material

Any multi-family development in the R-F(M), RT-1, RM-1, RM-2, RM-3, RM-4 and C-C zones shall provide a facility for garbage containers and recycling containers-passive.

Bins should be clearly labelled for source separation.

Any garbage and recycling containers located outdoors shall be completely screened to a height of at least two decimal five (2.5) metres (6 ft.) by buildings, solid decorative fence, a landscape screen or a combination thereof.

In the case of buildings constructed prior to June 30, 1991, one parking space per apartment building or townhouse cluster may be used for this purpose without affecting the parking requirement for the development."

2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Zoning By-law, 1979, No. [5942](#), Text Amendment By-law, 1991, No. 10916."

READ A FIRST AND SECOND TIME on the 29th day of April, 1991.

PUBLIC HEARING HELD thereon on the 27th day of May, 1991.

READ A THIRD TIME on the 3rd day of June, 1991.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY ADOPTED, signed by the Mayor and Clerk, and sealed with the Corporate Seal on the 17th day of June, 1991.
