

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 10929

A by-law to acquire statutory rights-of-way by expropriation for the use of the Corporation of the District of Surrey for the purposes of drainage works and dykes.

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WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey may by By-Law expropriate any real property or any interest in any real property in the Municipality for the purposes of drainage works and dykes.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the District of Surrey requires an interest, namely, a Statutory Right-of-Way in certain real property located in the Municipality for the purposes of drainage works and dykes.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This By-Law may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Expropriation By-Law, 1991, No. 10929."
2. The Corporation of the District of Surrey is hereby authorized to enter on, expropriate, take or enter into possession of and use as a statutory Right-of-Way and does hereby expropriate a Statutory Right-of-Way for the purposes of drainage works and dykes ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate in the Municipality of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly described as:

FIRSTLY: That portion of Parcel 1, Section 14, Township 2, New Westminster District, Plan 82064 shown as Statutory Right-of-Way as outlined on Statutory Right-of-Way Plan NWP88173 containing 1.494 hectares for the purpose of Drainage and Dyking, a reduced copy of which plan is attached hereto as Schedule "A".

SECONDLY: That portion of Parcel 1, Section 14, Township 2, New Westminster District, Reference Plan 82063 shown as Statutory Right-of-Way as outlined on Statutory Right-of-Way Plan NWP88173 containing 3.149 hectares for the purpose of Drainage and Dyking, a reduced copy of which plan is attached hereto as Schedule "A".

3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and to affix the Corporate Seal of The Corporation of the District of Surrey to all plans and documents and to do all things incidental to the subject expropriation, including, the execution of the general form of the Statutory Right-of-Way Agreement, copies of which are attached hereto as Schedules "B" and "C".

PASSED THREE READINGS by the Municipal Council on the 6th day of May, 1991.
