

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 11635

A by-law to authorize the expenditure of monies in the "Fire Hall Buildings Reserve Fund".

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated cash balance in the Fire Hall Buildings Reserve Fund of approximately One Million Five Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,320,000.00) as at June 30, 1992, pursuant to "Fire Hall Buildings Reserve Fund By-law, 1990, No. [10632](#)";

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside in the Fire Hall Buildings Reserve Fund in the amount of One Million Three Hundred and Twenty Two Thousand Dollars (\$1,320,000.00) for the purpose of constructing Fire Hall #17.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of One Million Three Hundred and Twenty Two Thousand Dollars (\$1,320,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Fire Hall Buildings Reserve Fund to be expended for the purpose of constructing Fire Hall #17.
2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of the Council.
3. Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditure hereby authorized has been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Fire Hall Buildings Reserve Fund Expenditure Authorization By-law, 1993, No. 11635."

PASSED THREE READINGS by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Surrey on the 11th day of January, 1993.
