BY-LAW NO. 11969

A by-law to establish municipal voting divisions.

.....

WHEREAS the "Municipal Act" requires that the council of a municipality with a population of greater than 100,000 must, by by-law:

- (a) establish municipal voting divisions, or
- (b) authorize the clerk or chief election officer to establish municipal voting divisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Subject to any requirements, limits and conditions established by regulation under Section 156 of the Municipal Act, municipal voting divisions are to be used for each election, and for the 1993 municipal election, there are hereby established seventy (70) municipal voting divisions as shown outlined in Schedule "A" attached hereto as a part of this by-law.
2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Municipal Voting Divisions Establishment By-law, 1993, No. 11969."

READ A FIRST AND SECOND TIME on the 27th day of July, 1993.

READ A THIRD TIME on the 30th of August, 1993.
