BY-LAW NO. 12475

A by-law to amend the provisions of  
"Surrey Smoking Regulation By-law,  
1988, No. 9400", as amended.

The Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **"Surrey Smoking Regulation By-law, 1988, No. 9400"**, as amended is hereby further amended by deleting Section 7. and inserting the following in its place:

"7. No person shall smoke in a restaurant, except that a person may smoke in a smoking area, which area shall not occupy more than 20% of the seating area and provided that if a smoking area is designated, patrons of the restaurant shall be given the option of being seated in a smoking area or non-smoking area."

2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Smoking Regulation By-law, 1988, No. 9400, Amendment By-law, 1994, No. 12475."

PASSED THREE READINGS on the 24th day of October, 1994.

RECEIVED the approval of the Minister of Health and Minister Responsible for Seniors this 19th day of January, 1995.
