BY-LAW NO. 12598

A by-law to provide for an Eight-Year
Capital Budget for the City of Surrey.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 266 of the "Municipal Act" being R.S.B.C. 1979 as amended, the City Council is required to adopt by By-law a capital expenditure program for a period of not less than five years, showing estimates of the proposed source of application of funds for capital purposes for each year of the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Schedule "A" of this By-law No. [12598](#) is hereby adopted by the Council as the eight-year capital expenditure for the Years 1995 to 2002 inclusive and Schedule "A" is hereby attached to and made part of this By-law.
2. Surrey Nine-Year Capital Budget Adoption By-law, 1994, No. [12291](#)" is hereby repealed.
3. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Eight-Year Capital Budget Adoption By-law, 1995, No. 12598."
