

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 12664

A by-law to acquire lands by expropriation for the purpose of a Statutory Right-of-Way for the purpose of public rights of passage with or without vehicles , sanitary sewer, watermain, sidewalk, streetlights, B.C. Hydro works, B.C. Gas works, B.C. Tel works and cablevision works.

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WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey has found it necessary to acquire the within described property for the purpose of a Statutory Right-of-Way for the purpose of public rights of passage with or without vehicles , sanitary sewer, watermain, sidewalk, streetlights, B.C. Hydro works, B.C. Gas works, B.C. Tel works and cablevision works;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 578 of the "Municipal Act" of the Province of British Columbia, the City Council may by by-law establish a highway or any portion of a highway;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 578(3) of the "Municipal Act" of the Province of British Columbia, the City Council may acquire property by expropriation and have free entry thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to Section 578(3) and subject to Division 4 of PART XII of the "Municipal Act" of the Province of British Columbia, the Council of the City of Surrey is hereby authorized to enter upon, expropriate, break up, take and enter into possession of and use for the purpose of a Statutory Right-of-Way for the purpose of public rights of passage with or without vehicles , sanitary sewer, watermain, sidewalk, streetlights, B.C. Hydro works, B.C. Gas works, B.C. Tel works and cablevision works, ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey in the Province of British Columbia and being:

All that portion of Parcel "A" (H85681E) Lot 1, Section 28, Township 2, New Westminster District, shown in heavy black outline on a Reference Plan attached hereto, prepared by Peter M. Mueller, B.C.L.S. on the 22nd day of June, 1995, and containing 88 square metres.

(Portion of 8704 - 140 Street)

2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and seal all documents necessary and incidental to effect such expropriation.

3. This By-law shall not come into effect until a certified copy of the By-law has been filed in the Land Titles Office in the City of New Westminster, and a Notice of Expropriation has been served on the registered owners of the land.

4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of 8704 - 140 Street Expropriation By-law, 1995, No. 12664."
