BY-LAW NO. 12876

A by-law to establish municipal voting divisions.
.....

WHEREAS Section 103 of the "Municipal Act", R.S.B.C., Chapter 290, requires that the council of a municipality with a population of greater than 100,000 must, by by-law:

- (a) establish municipal voting divisions, or
- (b) authorize the clerk or chief election officer to establish municipal voting divisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Subject to any requirements, limits and conditions established by regulation under Section 156 of the Municipal Act, municipal voting divisions are to be used for each election, and general local elections, by-elections and any referendums, there are hereby established seventy (70) municipal voting divisions as shown outlined in Schedule "A" attached hereto as a part of this By-law.
2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Voting Divisions Establishment By-law, 1996, No. 12876."

PASSED THREE READINGS the 8th day of July, 1996.
