

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 13343

A by-law to establish municipal voting divisions
for the 1998 by-election.

.....

WHEREAS Section 103 of the "Municipal Act", R.S.B.C. 1996, Chapter 323, requires that the council of a municipality with a population of greater than 100,000 must, by by-law:

- (a) establish municipal voting divisions, or
- (b) authorize the clerk or chief election officer to establish municipal voting divisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Subject to any requirements, limits and conditions established by regulation under Section 156 of the Municipal Act, municipal voting divisions are to be used for each by-election and there are hereby established twenty-one (21) municipal voting divisions as shown outlined in Schedule "A" attached hereto as a part of this By-law.

REPEAL

2. "Surrey Voting Divisions Establishment By-law, 1996, No. 12876" is hereby repealed.

CITATION

3. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey By-Election Voting Divisions Establishment By-law, 1998, No. 13343".
