

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 13498

A by-law to amend the provisions of "Business License By-law, 1976, No. 4747," as amended.

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The Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Business License By-law, 1976, No. 4747," as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

(a) Section 2. is amended by inserting new definition "Alcohol and Drug Recovery House" immediately following the definition of "Adult Entertainment Store" as follows:

" 'Alcohol and Drug Recovery House' means a *building* which contains *sleeping units* for persons receiving care and support for recovery from alcohol and drug dependency."

(b) Section 2. is amended by inserting new definition "Chief Constable" immediately following the definition of "Cabaret" as follows:

" 'Chief Constable' means the Chief of Police of the City of Surrey for the time being or the senior resident member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Force responsible for the policing of the City."

(c) Section 20. is amended by inserting new Subsection (y) immediately following Subsection (x)(iii) as follows:

"(y) The operation of an alcohol and drug recovery house shall be subject to the following requirements and regulations:

(i) Every person applying for an *alcohol and drug recovery house business license* shall submit to a criminal background check.

(ii) Every operator of an *alcohol and drug recovery house* shall provide and keep a register book of all persons provided accommodation, including dates of arrival and departure.

(iii) The operator of an *alcohol and drug recovery house* shall require every person provided accommodation to sign the register.

(iv) The registration records to which this section refers shall be produced for inspection at the request of any *Inspector* or *Chief Constable*."

(d) Schedule "A" is amended by inserting new Section 2. immediately following the third Note as follows:

"2. Alcohol and Drug Recovery House

From every person carrying on the business of an Alcohol and Drug Recovery House, the sum of FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY FIVE DOLLARS AND 50 CENTS (\$555.50) for every twelve (12) months."

2. Section 1.(d) of this by-law shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of April, 1999.

3. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Business License By-law, 1976, No. 4747, Amendment By-law, 1998, No. 13498."

PASSED THREE READINGS on the 20th day of July, 1998.
