BY-LAW NO. 13623

A by-law to amend the provisions of "Business License By-law, 1976, No. 4747" as amended.

The Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Business License By-law, 1976, No. 4747," as amended is hereby further amended as follows:

(1) Section 2. is amended by inserting the definitions of "Pepper Spray" and "Pepper Spray Vendor" immediately after the definition "Pedlar" as follows:

"Pepper Spray" means any article or substance containing oleoresin capsicum spray, also known as pepper spray and o.c. spray.

"Pepper Spray Vendor" means a place of business where pepper spray is retailed to the general public.

(2) New Section 103. is inserted immediately after Section 102. as follows:

103. Pepper Spray Vendor:

From every person carrying on the business of a pepper spray vendor, the sum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) for every twelve (12) months.

2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Business License By-law, 1976, No. 4747, Amendment By-law, 1998, No. 13623."
