BY-LAW NO. 14121

A by-law to stop up and close a portion of  
68 Avenue at Fraser Highway.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey, pursuant to Section 527(1) of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended, may by by-law, stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portion of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled,  
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. 68 Avenue, at a line commencing at the most Easterly corner of Lot "A" Section 16 Township 8 New Westminster District Plan 7083.

Thence Southeasterly on said line to a point on the Northerly boundary of remainder Lot 2 Section 16 Township 8 New Westminster District Plan 16057 said point being 3.935 metres Easterly from the most Northwesterly corner of the said remainder Lot 2.

Said line shown heavy dashed on sketch attached hereto.

(Portion of 68 Avenue, on the west side of Fraser Highway)

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

2. This By-law may be cited as "Surrey Stop Up and Close of 68 Avenue at Fraser Highway By-law, 2000, No. 14121".

PASSED THREE READINGS on the 18th day of September, 2000.
