BY-LAW NO. 14188

A by-law to amend the provisions of "Surrey

Plumbing By-law, 1981, No. [6569](#)," as amended.

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The Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Surrey Plumbing By-law, 1981, No. [6569](#)," as amended is hereby further amended as follows:

1 Section 9 - Scale of Fees, is amended by deleting subsection 9.6 to subsection 9.18 and inserting new subsections 9.6 to 9.18 in their place as per the attached schedule.

(2) Section 10, Fees for Additional Inspections is amended by deleting subsection 10.1 to subsection 10.3 and inserting new subsections 10.1 to 10.3 in their place as per the attached schedule.

2. The provisions of this by-law shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January 2001.

3. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Plumbing By-law, 1981, No. 6569, Amendment By-law, 2000, No. 14188."

9.7	For the alterations or remodeling of any plumbing, where no additional fixtures are installed, a fee of	\$45.00
9.8	For the installation of any fire sprinkler system, for the first two (2) heads, a fee of	\$28.00
	for each additional head, a fee of	\$1.40
9.9	For the installation of any fire water service line, for the first one hundred (100) feet	\$45.00
	for each additional one hundred (100) feet, or portion thereof	\$28.00
	hydrants and standpipes, per hydrant or standpipe fee	\$28.00
9.10	Except in the case of a single family residence, for the installation of storm or sanitary sewer systems and water service connections over 3/4 inches in diameter, the first one hundred (100) feet, a fee of	\$45.00
	for each additional one hundred (100) feet or a portion thereof	\$28.00
9.12	For connection of a single family residence to sanitary sewer	\$45.00
9.13	For the installation of swimming pool supply and drainage lines, including a sanitary or storm sewer service connection where required, a fee of	\$55.50
9.14	For the connection of domestic water from private supply to City supply	\$45.00
9.15	For the removal and replacement of existing piping in multi-family dwellings, per unit	\$18.00

9.16	For the Transfer or Assignment of a Plumbing Permit and to record a change of contractor for a project	\$55.50
9.17	For the installation of an hydronic heating system

10. Fees for Additional Inspections

10.1	On any portion of the work, the permit holder shall be entitled to one reinspection. On jobs which could be completely inspected at one inspection, the permit holder shall be entitled to two (2) inspections under the permit fee.	
10.2	Where an additional reinspection is required due to failure of the permit holder to correct the work previously inspected or due to any other fault of the permit holder, a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be paid for each such additional inspection.	\$52.00
10.3	Where an applicant wishes a special inspection not provided for in the fee schedule, the fee shall be:	
	(a) during normal working hours	\$57.00
	(b) after hours during which the offices of the City Hall are normally open, the fee, in addition to other required fees, to be based on the time actually spent in making such inspection, including travelling time	\$395.00 plus \$99.00
