BY-LAW NO. 14189

A by-law to amend the provisions of “Surrey

Electrical Inspection Safety By-law, 1976, No. [4832](#),”

as amended.

The Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. “Surrey Electrical Inspection Safety By-law, 1976, No. [4832](#),” as amended is hereby further amended as follows:

1 Schedule A is deleted in its entirety and new Schedule A is inserted as per the attached schedule.

2. The provisions of this by-law shall come into force and effect on the 1st day of January, 2001.

3. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as “Surrey Electrical Inspection Safety By-law, 1976, No. 4832, Amendment By-law, 2000, No. 14189.”

PASSED THREE READINGS by the City Council on the 28th day of November,2000.

ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEES

SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW NO. 4832

1. Regular Permits

Fees for regular permits are based on the value of the electrical installation, including all material and labour and fees for design, testing, consulting, and monetary worth of contributed labour and materials.

Permit fees for homeowner permits are based on a deemed installation value of three times the cost of materials.

Value of Electrical Installation	Fee
\$0 - \$300	\$40.00
\$301 - \$700	\$64.50
\$701 - \$1,000	\$90.00
\$1,001 - \$10,000	\$90 plus \$28.00 per \$1,000 (or part thereof over \$1,000)
\$10,001 - \$50,000	\$343 plus \$1,400 per \$1,000 (or part thereof over \$10,000)
\$50,001 - \$100,000	\$884.00 plus \$9.35 per \$1,000 (or part thereof over \$50,000)
\$100,001 - \$500,000	\$1,352.00 plus \$7.50 per \$1,000 (or part thereof over \$100,000)
\$500,001 - \$1,000,000	\$4,370.00 plus \$4.50 per \$1,000 (or part thereof over \$500,000)
\$1,000,001 -and over	\$6,580.00 plus \$2.95 per \$1,000 (or part thereof over \$1,000,000)

Electrical Permit fees will be divided into two portions. Ten percent of the estimated Electrical Permit Fee will be deemed applicable to plan checking and 90% of the estimated Electrical Permit fee will be deemed applicable to inspection charges. Where one or more letters of assurance from a registered professional are required, the plan checking amount will be reduced by 10% to a maximum deduction of \$500.

4. Temporary Entertainment Permits	
(a) the fee for a temporary entertainment permit (carnival, movie set,	\$68.00

5. Annual Permits

Fees for annual permits shall be:

(a) for a commercial or industrial
installation

i. per kva of service capacity
adjusted to nearest dollar \$0.21

ii. minimum fee \$78.00

iii. maximum fee \$78.00

(b) for educational facility installation

i. for each classroom, shop, laboratory,
gymnasium, auditorium \$2.10

ii. minimum fee \$75.00

iii. maximum fee \$2,100.00

(c) for entertainment equipment set-up

i. for each set-up location \$68.00

ii. minimum fee \$240.00

6. Survey Permits

(a) The fee for a survey of single or duplex
dwellings. \$57.00
[one hour minimum]

(b) The fee for a survey of commercial or
industrial premises \$88.50
[one hour minimum]

7. Special Inspections

Where an applicant wishes a special
inspection not provided for in the fee schedule,
the fee shall be:

(a) during normal working hours \$57.00
[one hour minimum]

(b) after hours during which the offices of
the City Hall are normally open, the fee, in
addition to other required fees, to be based on
the time actually spent in making such
inspection, including travelling time. \$395.00 plus \$99.00 per
hour for each hour or
part thereof beyond 4
hours
