A by-law to authorize the expenditure of monies
in the “Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan
Areas.”
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WHEREAS pursuant to Section 496(1) of the “Local Government Act”, being Chapter 323, R.S.B.C., 1996, as amended, Council has established a Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 496(4) of the said “Local Government Act”, it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside in the Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of One Million Eight Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$1,870,000) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas, specifically for:
 - a) North Cloverdale West, Library Services, in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000),
 - b) North Cloverdale West, Park Development, in the sum of Three Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$360,000),
 - c) North Cloverdale, East, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000),
 - d) North Cloverdale, East, Park Development, in the sum of Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$260,000),
 - e) East Newton North, Library Services, in the sum of Thirty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$38,000),
 - f) East Newton North, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000),
 - g) East Newton South, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000),
 - h) East Newton South, Park Development, in the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000),

- i) West Cloverdale North, Fire Services, in the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000),
- j) West Cloverdale North, Library Services, in the sum of Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$47,000),
- k) West Cloverdale North, Park Development, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000),
- l) West Newton North, Fire Services, in the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000),
- m) West Newton North, Library Services, in the sum of Twenty-one Thousand Dollars (\$21,000),
- n) West Newton North, Park Development, in the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000),
- o) West Newton South, Fire Services, in the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000),
- p) West Newton South, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000),
- q) Rosemary Heights Central, Library Services, in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000),
- r) Rosemary Heights Central, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000),
- s) South Newton, Library Services, in the sum of Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$19,000),
- t) South Newton, Park Development, in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000),
- u) South Newton, Fire Services, in the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) and,
- v) South Newton, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000).

To be expended for the following purpose for the Year 2002:

North Cloverdale School, Park Site & Greenbelts	\$ 620,000
East Newton North School, Park Site & Greenbelts	160,000
West Newton Reservoir Neighbourhood Park	160,000
Rosemary Heights School, Park Site & Tennis Courts	140,000
Fleetwood Athletic Park & Neighbourhood Park Sites	120,000
East Newton Park Site & Greenbelt Improvements	60,000
South Newton Community Park	50,000
Tamanawis School & Park Site	40,000
West Cloverdale Park Site & Greenbelts Improvements	20,000

Library Materials	200,000
Fire Services Equipment	<u>300,000</u>

2. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditure hereby authorized has been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
3. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as “Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas Reserve Fund Expenditure Authorization By-law, 2001, No. 14573”.
