BY-LAW NO. 14833

A by-law to amend the provisions of "Surrey Fee-Setting By-law, 2001, No. 14577" as amended.
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The Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Surrey Fee-Setting By-law, 2001, No. 14577" as amended is hereby further amended as follows:
 - (a) New Section 4.1 is inserted immediately following existing Section 4 as follows:

"4.1 Pursuant to Section 363 of the "Local Government Act" there is hereby levied a fee for Real Estate Division services provided as set out in Schedule "C" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law."
 - (b) New Schedule "C" is inserted immediately following existing Schedule "B" as attached.

2. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Fee-Setting By-law, 2001, No. 14577, Amendment By-law, 2002, No. 14833".

Schedule C

Surrey Fee-Setting By-law

Pursuant to Section 363 of the "Local Government Act" there is hereby levied a fee for Real Estate Division services provided as follows:

	<u>Services Provided</u>	<u>Fee</u>
1.	Road Closure/Exchange	\$2,000.00 per closure or exchange, inclusive of GST

Real Estate Division services are more particularly described as:

Road Closure/Exchanges

Except where a road or lane closure or exchange is initiated by the City, applicants for a road or lane closure or exchange shall pay a processing fee of \$2,000.00 inclusive of GST. This fee is payable after Council approval of the closure or exchange but before introduction of the closure or exchange by-law. This fee is non-refundable.
