BY-LAW NO. 14908

A by-law to authorize the expenditure of monies
in the “Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision
of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood
Concept Plan Areas.”

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 496(1) of the “Local Government Act”, being Chapter 323, R.S.B.C., 1996, as amended, Council has established a Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 496(4) of the said “Local Government Act”, it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside in the Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of One Million Seven Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$1,740,000) is hereby appropriated from the Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas, specifically for:
 - a) North Cloverdale West, Fire Services, in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000),
 - b) North Cloverdale West, Park Development, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000),
 - c) North Cloverdale, East, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000),
 - d) North Cloverdale, East, Park Development, in the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000),
 - e) East Newton North, Library Services, in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000),
 - f) East Newton North, Fire Services, in the sum of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000),
 - g) East Newton North, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000),
 - h) East Newton South, Library Services, in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000),
 - i) East Newton South, Fire Services, in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000),

- j) East Newton South, Park Development, in the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000),
- k) East Clayton, Park Development, in the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000),
- l) West Cloverdale North, Library Services, in the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000),
- m) West Cloverdale North, Fire Services, in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000),
- n) West Cloverdale North, Park Development, in the sum of Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000),
- o) West Cloverdale South, Park Development, in the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000),
- p) West Newton North, Park Development, in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000),
- q) West Newton South, Park Development, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000),
- r) Rosemary Heights West, Park Development, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000),
- s) Rosemary Heights Central, Library Services, in the sum of Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000),
- t) Rosemary Heights Central, Fire Services, in the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000),
- u) Rosemary Heights Central, Police Services, in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000),
- v) Rosemary Heights Central, Park Development, in the sum of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$280,000),
- w) South Newton, Library Services, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000),
- x) South Newton, Park Development, in the sum of Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$95,000),
- y) Fleetwood Town Centre, Library Services, in the sum of Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000),
- z) Fleetwood Town Centre, Police Services, in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), and
- aa) Fleetwood Town Centre, Park Development, in the sum of Two Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$215,000).

To be expended for the following purpose for the Year 2003:

North Cloverdale School, Park Site & Greenbelts	\$ 95,000
East Newton School, Park Site & Greenbelts	200,000
West Newton Park Facilities, Tennis Courts & Playground	25,000

2. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditure hereby authorized has been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
3. This by-law shall be cited for all purposes as “Capital Works Reserve Fund for the Provision of Facilities and Amenities within Neighbourhood Concept Plan Areas Reserve Fund Expenditure Authorization By-law, 2003 No. 14908”.
