

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 15193

A by-law to authorize the expenditure  
of monies in the "Municipal Lands Reserve Fund".

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated cash balance in the Municipal Lands Reserve Fund of approximately Eighteen Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$18,700,000) as at November 1, 2003, pursuant to "Municipal Lands Reserve Fund By-law, 1980, No. 6474";

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside in the Municipal Lands Reserve Fund in the amount of Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$8,500,000) for the purposes of:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

1. The sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Funds for the purpose of building a Multi-Purpose Recreation Centre and RCMP Office in Fraser Heights.
2. The sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Funds for the purpose of building a Surrey Museum and Archives.
3. The sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Funds for the purpose of Bridge Replacement.

4. The sum of Nine Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$925,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Funds for the purpose of renovating the Main RCMP Detachment.
5. The sum of Four Hundred Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$485,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Fund for the purpose of improving the parking at Bear Creek Park.
6. The sum of Four Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$470,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Fund for the purpose of rehabilitating Non-Arterial Roads.
7. The sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Fund for the purpose renovating the upper floor of the Surrey Sport & Leisure Complex.
8. The sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Fund for the purpose of creating a Playground and Tennis Courts in Fraser Heights.
9. The sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Fund for the purpose of paying the realty and legal costs related to the sale and exchange of City Lands.
10. The sum of Two Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$255,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Fund for the purpose of developing Greenways throughout the City of Surrey.
11. The sum of Two Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$240,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Fund for the purpose of creating a Youth Park in the Guildford/Hjorth Road Park area.
12. The sum of Two Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$225,000) is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Lands Reserve Fund for the purpose of renovating the family change rooms at the South Surrey Pool.
13. The expenditures to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of the Council.
14. Should any of the above amounts remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
15. This by-law shall be cited for all purposes as “Municipal Lands Reserve Fund Expenditure Authorization By-law, 2003, No. 15193”.

PASSED THREE READINGS by the City Council on the 24th day of November, 2003.
