BY-LAW NO. 15753

A by-law to provide for required and additional advance voting opportunities.

WHEREAS pursuant to Sections 97 and 98 of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, Chapter 323, as amended, (the "*Local Government Act*") the Council of the City of Surrey may, by by-law, establish dates for additional voting opportunities in advance of general voting day, designate the voting places, and set the voting hours for these voting opportunities;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 97 of the *Local Government Act* an advance voting opportunity must be held on the 10th day before general voting day;

AND WHEREAS the Council wishes to establish advance voting opportunities pursuant to Sections 97 and 98 of the *Local Government Act*;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

ADVANCE VOTING OPPORTUNITIES

1. (1) The following advance voting opportunities are established for the 2005 election, to be held in advance of general voting day:

(a) the advance voting opportunities will be available at the following locations:

Fleetwood Community Recreation Centre
15996 - 84 Avenue, Surrey BC

- and -

Elgin Heritage Park (Threshing Shed)
13723 Crescent Road, Surrey BC

(b) the advance voting opportunities will be held on the following dates:

Saturday, November 5, 2005
Monday, November 7, 2005
Tuesday, November 8, 2005
Wednesday, November 9, 2005
Thursday, November 10, 2005

(c) the voting hours at the advance voting opportunities will be:

8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

REPEALS

2. "Advance Voting Opportunities Establishment By-law, 2002, No. 14713" is hereby repealed.

CITATION

3. This By-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Advance Voting Opportunities Establishment By-law, 2005, No. 15753."
