

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 16291

A By-law to close and to remove the dedication
of a highway of a portion of road at 104 Avenue and 122 Street.

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WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a by-law under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey in open meeting assembled, ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of road lying in Section 19 Block 5 North Range 2 West New Westminister District, shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan attached hereto, and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Montgomery C. Brisson, B.C.L.S. on the 9th day of February, 2007, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of road dedicated by Plan LMP51971, called Parcel "A" and containing 0.323 hectares,

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of Road)

shall be closed to traffic.

2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of road.
3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of Road at 104 Avenue and 122 Street By-law, 2007, No. 16291".

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME on the 26th day of February, 2007.
