

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 17139

A By-law to close and to remove the dedication
of a highway of a portion road.

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WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a by-law under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey in open meeting assembled, ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of road lying in Section 10, Block 5 North, Range 2 West, New Westminster District, shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan attached hereto, and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Greg Marston, B.C.L.S. on the 17th day of December, 2009, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of road called Parcel A (Bylaw Plan BCP_____) formerly road dedicated on Plan 57918, and containing 219.0 square metres

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of 132A Street)

shall be closed to traffic.

2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of 132A Street.
3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of 132A Street fronting 116 Avenue By-law, 2010, No. 17139."

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME on the 22nd day of March, 2010.
