The Council of the City of Surrey ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. "Surrey Plumbing By-law, 1981, No. 6569," as amended is hereby further amended as follows:
 - (a) Section 9, subsection (9.6) to subsection (9.17) and section 10, subsection (10.1) to subsection (10.4), are amended by replacing the existing fees with the "Proposed Fees" as per the attached schedule 1.
2. This Bylaw shall be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Plumbing Bylaw, 1981, No. 6569, Amendment Bylaw, 2013, No. 18132".



10. <u>Fees for Additional Inspections</u>		
(1) On any portion of the work, the permit holder shall be entitled to one reinspection.		
(2) A \$79.00 reinspection fee will be imposed whenever an inspection was called for and the work to be inspected was not ready for inspection. Inspections not ready shall be deemed to include any inspection called for where the work to be inspected was not complete or where there was a substantial number of deficiencies which showed that the work was not checked over prior to calling for inspection.	\$ 77.00	\$ 79.00
(3) For second and further reinspections subsequent to a reinspection in paragraph (2)	\$129.00	\$133.00
(4) Where an applicant wishes a special inspection not provided for in the fee schedule, the fee shall be:		
(a) during normal working hours	\$ 77.00/hr. one hour min.	\$ 79.00/hr. one hour min.
(b) after hours during which the offices of the City Hall are normally open, the fee, in addition to other required fees, to be based on the time actually spent in making such inspection, including travelling time	\$535.00 plus \$133.00 per hour for each hour or part thereof beyond the first 4 hours	\$551.00 plus \$137.00 per hour for each hour or part thereof beyond the first 4 hours
