BYLAW NO. 18506

A Bylaw to authorize the Termination of
Land Use Contract Number 57.
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WHEREAS on the 18th day of September 1975, this City entered into a Land Use Contract with Thomas Henry May and Lorraine Dorothy May for the use and development of the lands therein described;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient that the rights and obligations created and to be performed under the said Land Use Contract should terminate and be no longer of force or effect;

AND WHEREAS Section 914.2 (2) and 890.1 of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended, provides that a Land Use Contract may only be terminated by bylaw and only after a Public Hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Land Use Contract No. 57, respecting the use and development of lands known as:

Parcel Identifier: 004-996-739
Lot 55 Section 30 Township 2 New Westminster District Plan 52254
(8585 - 123 Street)

Those portions of 123 Street, 85A Avenue and 86 Avenue
if included in Land Use Contract No. 57

registered in the New Westminster Land Title Office on the 19th day of September, 1975 under Filing Number L79985, is terminated.

2. THAT the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and affix the seal of the Corporation to such instrument as will effectually extinguish all rights and obligations created by the Land Use Contract and will release and terminate the Land Use Contract from the records of title to aforesaid lands in the New Westminster Land Title Office.

3. This Bylaw shall come into effect one year after the date of final adoption.
4. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Land Use Contract No. 57, Termination Bylaw, 2015, No. 18506"


PASSED FIRST READING on the 14th day of September, 2015.

PASSED SECOND READING on the 14th day of September, 2015.


PUBLIC HEARING HELD thereon on the 20th day of October, 2015.
